Building the Auto Show...By the Numbers...

It takes almost a week to setup the auto show, but teardown takes less than 48 hours.

The show covers approximately 6 football fields of exhibit space.

Approximately 65 truck loads of display and exhibit space are unloaded before the show starts.

The auto show uses enough carpet to cover 210 average-sized homes.

About 400 workers build the auto show in 12,000 hours, using:

- 30 miles of carpet tape
- 4,000 square feet of signs
- 11,360 feet of extension cords
- 400 overhead quartz lights
- 400 electrical outlets with enough electricity for nearly 500 homes

What You May Not Know About the Auto Show...

When move-in is complete, more than 500 brand new vehicles from 35 manufacturers will fill the Phoenix Convention Center.

More than 75 vehicles are available for road tests this year.

Attendees can't buy a car at the auto show; it's a chance to explore and compare nearly 500 vehicles all in one place.

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
